In collaboration with the ICRC Virtual Reality team, the Centre of Competence on Humanitarian Negotiation (CCHN) is developing a virtual negotiation simulation based on Artificial Intelligence which will allow humanitarians to fully immerse themselves into a realistic field negotiation scenario.

By attempting to negotiate passage through a checkpoint, professionals will exchange with an avatar whose reactions are trained through the experiences of actual humanitarian negotiators, putting their skills and strategies to the test.
